General Manager's Message

Our board of directors held our annual board meeting on December 18th and I'm happy to report that we've added two board members for 2018, Jim Hanko from Bemidji and Joe Breiter from Brainerd. Jim Hanko is no stranger to our board and served two terms in the past and also served as board chair during a very busy time for the organization during our Building for the Future campaign. Joe Breiter is new to the board and serves as the Director of Business Development for Widseth, Smith, Nolting, a local architecture and engineering firm. If you know either Jim or Joe, please thank them for their service. I also want to thank Mike Smith of Bemidji and acknowledge his service to the organization. Mike is stepping down from his role of board chair. He served as our board chair for the past two years and did an excellent job in that role. Ray Gildow is stepping into the board chair role for 2018 and has held that role in the past as well. I'm looking forward to working with Ray and the entire board as we enter 2018.

In addition, every year at our annual meeting we honor a very special volunteer with an award called the John Yourd Pillar Award. John Yourd was one of the founders of Lakeland Public Television and worked tirelessly for over ten years to bring public television to Northern Minnesota throughout the 70s. His dream was realized when KAWB went on the air in June of 1980. John was also instrumental in helping bring KAWB channel 22 to the Brainerd lakes area in 1988. John was not only generous with his time, but also with his treasure. John and his wife Dana donated their lake home to Lakeland Public Television shortly before John passed away in 1999. John had terminal cancer at the time and John and Dana set up a charitable gift annuity so that Dana would be taken care of with a fixed quarterly payment for life from the proceeds of the funds they donated. John and Dana's past contribution to Lakeland Public Television is still helping Lakeland Public Television to this day through our endowment fund.



Kevin Van Dyck was honored as our 2017 John Yourd Pillar Award recipient. Kevin has volunteered for Lakeland Public Television's Lakeland News at 10 production for close 20 years. Kevin works behind the scenes on the production and his role is instrumental in making the news happen each night he volunteers, which is frequent and roughly once to twice a week for the entire 20 year history of Lakeland News. If you know Kevin, please congratulate him and thank him for his outstanding service!

I've also want to share some exciting news about Lakeland Public Television. Beginning January 8th we're transitioning to a new name: Lakeland PBS. The reason for



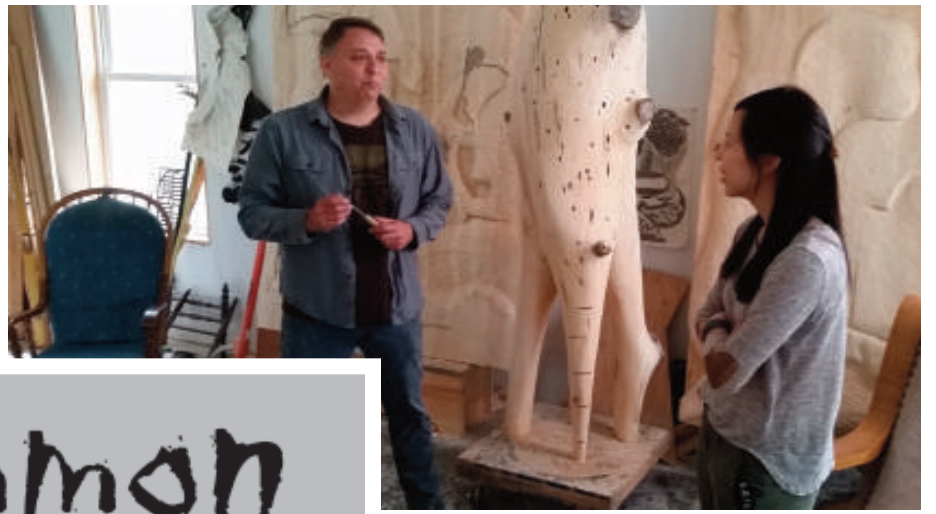
this is so that folks that aren't familiar with public television will better understand what we are when they hear our name. PBS is a highly trusted and widely recognized brand and we feel that by including PBS in our name, it will be a positive change for us. While we've been working hard to update our on-air materials for the January 8th introduction, this change will take considerable time to fully implement while being prudent with the transition. All of our existing printed materials, letterhead, envelopes, etc. will be used as normal. When we re-order, we will include the new logo and name. You will continue to see the Lakeland Public Television name in many of our local productions because anything produced prior to the name change will include that name. Going forward, new local productions will include the Lakeland PBS name. In addition, we have so many various video clips used for everything under the sun that will show up and need to be updated. This will take time. Our goal for January 8 is to have as much of the interstitial video clips updated as possible. This includes station ids, promos, Lakeland news clips, etc. and we'll work from there. As you might imagine, the more we look, the more we find that will need to be updated. Just think about what it would be like for you to change your own name! It's a BIG undertaking, but we feel that this is the right thing to do for our future and will help with our name recognition and branding going forward.

In closing, I'd like to thank everyone who supported our December pledge drive. It was good to see contributions up this December from last, which was down substantially. Our pledge drives are very important because they help bring in the funds needed to continue to provide you with the programming you enjoy throughout the year. All the programming you enjoy just isn't possible without your support. The local funds we raise during our pledge drives make our state and federal funding possible because much of our state and federal funding requires a local match.
