## Don’t Let A Gain Get You Down...

Spring is here and time to get off the couch on out and about to enjoy the temps that we thought might never arrive. Sometimes it seems that with spring comes acknowledgement of a bit of weight gain that can accompany a long, sedentary northern Minnesota winter. Nevertheless, I have some good news, and it is about the often-overlooked situation when a “gain” can be a good thing. I am frequently asked about the difference between making a gift of appreciated stock (stock that has increased in value since it was acquired) or cashing in the stock and then making a gift to a favorite nonprofit organization, such as Lakeland PBS, of the proceeds. Of course, both types of gift are received with gratitude but many wonder about the benefits of using one approach over the other. By making a gift of the appreciated stock directly to Lakeland PBS, you can avoid payment of capital gain taxes on the increase in value of the stock and therefore, many people prefer giving the appreciated stock rather than cashing the stock in and gifting the proceeds. This is easy to accomplish and we at Lakeland PBS have a one-page sheet that you can give your broker or financial advisor with all the important information to make this process effortless. As is always the case, if you have further questions on how making a gift of appreciated stock will affect your personal situation, it is best to secure advice from a knowledgeable and trusted professional tax, legal or financial advisor. ## General Manager’s Message

Summer is finally here and I’m hoping you’re all enjoying the warm weather as much as I am! This year, summer time is concert time here at Lakeland PBS. We’re holding two fundraising concerts over the course of this summer and fall. First, we have the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band on Tuesday, June 19 at 7pm. Then in the fall, by popular demand we’re bringing back Celtic Thunder. They will perform on Tuesday, Oct. 16 at 7pm. Both concerts will be at the Bemidji High School auditorium. I expect both of these shows to be fantastic. Tickets are selling fast for both concerts. Due to the smaller venue at the Bemidji High School auditorium, we expect both shows to sell out, so don’t wait and expect to buy tickets at the door the night of the show because they will likely be gone. TV stations like ours are big consumers of electricity. We consume a large amount of electricity and pay thousands of dollars per month to operate our transmitter sites and offices. I’m excited to tell you about a new project we just completed here at Lakeland PBS that will help with our electric bill and will also help the environment. We just finished up the installation of a large photovoltaic solar array at our headquarters here in Bemidji. This solar electric power system is anticipated to generate about 45,000 kWh of energy annually and will reduce our electric bill by well over \$400 per month. This electricity savings will also reduce greenhouse gas emissions over the life of the system.

Solar electric systems are generating a lot of interest right now. Organizations want to be seen as “green”. Most organizations that install solar electric systems do so as a “turn-key” project. That means that they hire one firm to do the entire project. There are advantages of doing this because this firm is responsible for everything and you have really no responsibilities other than writing a check when the project is done. The one disadvantage to this approach is that it’s expensive. You will certainly be doing the right thing for the environment with a project like this, but a turn-key solar project may ultimately not make good financial sense when you analyze the numbers.

Here at Lakeland PBS, we had the expertise to be the general contractor for our project. We researched and purchased the components and hired an electrical contractor to do the electrical installation and wiring. We also did as much of the physical work as possible and had our electrical contractor do the rest. This saved us a great deal of money. In addition, Otter Tail Power has a really remarkable rebate program for solar electric installations on public buildings in the form of a cash rebate available of \$1,250 per kW of installed solar panels or 50% of the project cost, whichever was less. This rebate saved us 50% of the cost of the project and we will receive a rebate check from Otter Tail Power for over \$30,000! This rebate, along with us doing a lot of the work turned a questionable project into one that made perfect sense. The installed cost for our complete system is about \$0.81 per installed watt of capacity after the Otter Tail Power rebate. This is a fantastic number that very few installations can match and allows this installation to pay for itself in 5-6 years. With a 25-30 year useful life, the system will be both helping the environment and saving Lakeland PBS money for many years to come. I’d like to thank Derek Hanson from Hanson Contracting, our electrical contractor, and also Otter Tail Power for their encouragement and fantastic rebate program. Both were great to work with and made the project not just possible, but fun as well.

Last month I provided you with an update regarding our federal funding. I’m happy to report that our funding is now secure through the current federal fiscal year. A BIG thank you to all of you that went online at [protectmypublicmedia.org](http://protectmypublicmedia.org) and voiced your opinion in support of federal funding for public media. Our federal legislators heard from literally thousands of folks like you that public media is important to them individually and to our country as a whole. Because of this strong grass-roots support, we have more allies that ever on both sides of the isle in Washington and are well positioned as we move forward.
