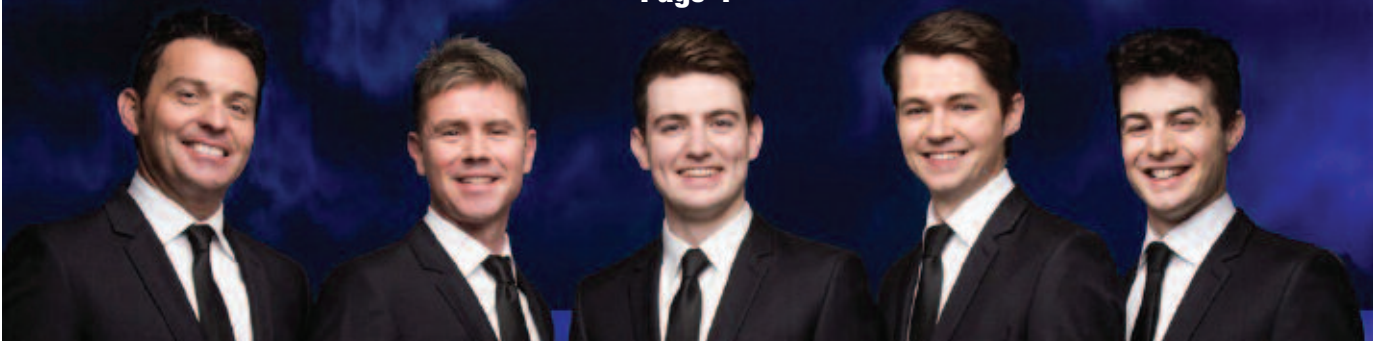

On May 15, 1987, a group of A-list musicians gathered to celebrate the enormous influence of guitarist Chet Atkins on their lives and careers. Taped in Nashville just blocks from the famed Music Row that he's largely credited with creating, this star-packed program includes performances by Atkins with Mark Knopfler, Emmylou Harris, Waylon Jennings, Willie Nelson, the Everly Brothers and a band of Music City's finest players.

Peter, Paul and Mary at Newport 1963-65

The program presents songs filmed during the emergence of the group as the most honored folk trio in history including “If I Had a Hammer,” “Blowin’ in the Wind,” and their only filmed renditions of such treasures as “Jesus Met the Woman at the Well,” “San Francisco Bay Blues,” “Rising of the Moon” and The Weavers’ iconic and powerful “Wasn’t that a Time.”

General Manager’s Message

This fall has been a busy one for us here at Lakeland PBS. If you’re familiar with our music series called Backroads, and even if you’re not, I’ve got some good news for you. The week of September 10th we set up a full multi-camera fields production sound stage at the Rail River Folks School in Bemidji and taped two episodes of Backroads each evening, Monday through Friday. We had live audiences each evening and came away with ten great new episodes that will begin airing later this fall. It was really a fun week. This year we had a wide variety of music and all the performers were fantastic. I’m very excited to see the finished programs and I hope that you enjoy the program as much as we enjoyed making them! Since we’re talking about local productions, the first week in October we’re hoisting a series of seven political debates for State of Minnesota House of Representative seats from around our region. Regardless of what side of the aisle you lean towards, there’s a lot at stake in this year’s midterm elections. Here at Lakeland PBS we’re pleased to bring the candidates right into your home with our series of debate broadcasts helping you to be more informed when you head to the polls.

Beginning in our Bemidji studio live October 1st at 7pm we will host a district 5B debate with incumbent Sandy Layman debating Pat Medure. Then at 8pm we will feature district 5A with incumbent Matt Bliss debating John Persell. We’ll take Tuesday night off and then Wednesday night at 7pm in our Bemidji Studio we will host a district 2B debate with incumbent Steve Green debating Karen Branden. Next at 8pm we will host a district 2A debate with incumbent Matt Grossell debating Michael Northbird. Thursday evening we move to our Brainerd studio for a live 8pm debate with incumbent John Poston debating challenger Alex Hering. Then Friday evening at 7pm in Brainerd, we will host district 10B candidates with incumbent Dale Lueck debating Phil Yetzer. Then at 8pm in Brainerd we host district 10A candidates with incumbent Josh Heintzeman debating Dale Menk. I hope you’ll tune in and learn more about the candidates for these important House seats so you can make an informed vote!

Also in October, we’re continuing with our 20 for 20 Lakeland News series that features a unique story from each of the past 20 years of Lakeland News. 1. I've heard the phrase "planned giving" but am not really sure I know what it means. What is a planned gift?

Planned giving is commonly understood to mean planning for the distribution of one's estate at death. This often involves distributions to family, as well as gifts to nonprofits that were important to the person during their life. Studies show that many people talk of leaving an estate gift to an organization that was important to them while they were living but they failed to formalize those wishes before their death and sadly the gift is not honored. By not taking the time to insure that their wishes will be honored, the gift is omitted from the distribution of their assets at death. In addition to honoring one's wishes for how their estate will be distributed, planned giving can provide useful tax savings at their death as well. Planned giving, like all estate planning, requires attention before death to insure that your wishes will be honored after death.

2. Isn't planned giving only for the very wealthy?

That is a common misconception about making a planned gift. All gifts have an impact in helping maintain and sustain the quality programming that Lakeland PBS provides. By making a planned gift everyone has the opportunity to leave a lasting legacy that will directly impact the quality of life for residents, young and old alike.

3. I am considering providing an estate gift to Lakeland PBS, but can I also provide for my children or grandchildren as well?

Yes, providing for family is what most people wish to achieve with the distribution of their estates at death. Yet, it is not uncommon for people to also provide for a distribution of a portion of their estate assets to an important nonprofit organization, such as Lakeland PBS. Making the decision to provide even a small portion of one's estate assets can have a huge impact in keeping high quality public television on the air. When estate planning incorporates a gift to both family as well as a valued nonprofit, like Lakeland PBS, the impact is a lasting legacy whose reach goes far beyond family members to help advance Lakeland PBS in their ongoing mission to EDUCATE, ENTERTAIN, ENRICH and ENLIGHTEN northern and central Minnesota.

4. Why should I make a planned gift to Lakeland PBS? Don't my tax dollars support public television?

Although Lakeland PBS does receive some support from both the state and federal government, the amount of government support has been dramatically falling over the past decade. Lakeland PBS is funded approximately 30 percent by government funding and 70 percent by local funding. In terms of our federal budget, all of public media made up less than .01 percent of the 2017 federal spending. In simple terms public television needs to plan for continued funding shortfalls. By being good stewards of the gifts we receive today, and working to secure gifts that will help us in the future, we will hopefully survive funding setbacks that might otherwise threaten our continued existence.

5. Can I change my mind about a planned gift?

Yes, most planned gifts are revocable meaning the person who established the gift can change his/her mind. There are a few types of planned gifts that are irrevocable which means once they are established they cannot be altered. Knowing about the different types of planned gifts is important. Lakeland PBS has an experienced, knowledgeable development specialist who can listen to your wishes and offer suggestions about what type of planned gift might be the most advantageous considering your circumstances. There is no cost or obligation to hear how a planned gift could be used in your estate planning and you may be surprised to find out just how easy it is to make a gift.

6. I am thinking about making a planned gift to Lakeland PBS, but am worried my kids will be mad at me if I do so?

When an estate plan is well crafted and well drafted, the wishes of the deceased person are honored. Estates that are problematic, such as where disgruntled children who are not

happy with their inheritance (or lack thereof), or when an heir questions the validity of a Will are actually very few. These make for great evening drama but the truth is that most estates are not contested. Furthermore, most estates are handled in an organized, orderly fashion, especially when good estate planning was used before death. If a parent has been supporting an organization for many years, adult children are not often surprised to see that their parent has made arrangements to support that organization with an estate gift.

7. I would like to make a planned gift to Lakeland PBS but don't want my gift to be acknowledged?

We will of course honor your wishes regarding gift recognition. If you are considering or have made arrangements for a planned gift to Lakeland PBS, we would like to know ahead of time primarily so we can appropriately express our appreciation. Some donors like to be acknowledged hoping their gift to Lakeland PBS might inspire others to do the same. We also have donors who simply prefer to make their gifts without any acknowledgement or recognition, and we will of course honor those wishes if we are made aware of such.

8. Is there any tax benefit to making a planned gift?

There well could be. Currently, Minnesota is one of the few states that still have a state estate tax. Estate gifts can help reduce or even eliminate this tax if an estate is large enough to be subject to such a tax. Additionally, there is a federal estate tax that applies to all estates that meet a certain threshold as well. Most estates never meet the federal threshold of 11.2 million dollars per person. Far more are subject to the state of Minnesota's estate tax and therefore a planned gift is a great way to continue to support the high quality television that daily educates, entertains, enriches and enlightens in the communities where it is broadcast, but it can also provide a beneficial tax benefit to reduce or even eliminate taxes that may be due at death.

9. Although there are a number of programs I enjoy watching on Lakeland PBS, I would like to provide support for keeping the local evening news. Can I provide a planned gift that goes exclusively to support a particular type of program at Lakeland PBS?

Yes indeed! Many Lakeland supporters have a favorite program or two. Whatever your particular area of interest is, we would welcome your financial support and can direct that support to the programming area that you wish such as local news, local arts programming, even children's programming - whatever your favorite, you can help us keep that high quality television going for years to come.

10. I am not certain that I am ready to make a planned gift, but I am interested in hearing more, who should I contact?

The development specialist at Lakeland PBS, Kathleen McKinstra, would welcome the opportunity to meet with you in person. Kathleen spent over twenty years as a practicing attorney in the area of estate planning and is a wonderful resource to listen to your wishes regarding the distribution of your estate and offer some ideas about how you might achieve such goals. Kathleen will gladly meet with you at our office in either Bemidji or Brainerd or if you would prefer, she can arrange to visit you in your home. There is no cost to talking with her or any obligation to make a planned gift. You may simply want to find out about the many ways a planned gift can easily be incorporated into your estate plan when you start the process of getting your estate affairs in order. Kathleen would welcome the opportunity to hear of the impact Lakeland PBS has had in your life and further how making a planned gift to Lakeland PBS will allow you to leave a lasting legacy for generations to come.
