



LPTV Passport is a member benefit that gives eligible donors and supporters extended access to an on-demand library of quality public television programming online. The LPTV Passport library currently offers members more than 1,000 episodes to watch, with new PBS programs being added weekly. You can enjoy past episodes of many of your favorite PBS shows on demand using your computer, smartphone or tablet and other devices as follows with more devices coming soon!

PBS is working hard to secure program rights for all of our content and we are hopeful that soon this will be a viewing option for you. 
