# Masterpiece: Sandition

*This 8-part series begins Sunday, January 12 at 8pm*

When Jane Austen was chronically ill with a mysterious disease in early 1817, she turned her thoughts to a happier subject. She started work on a witty and delightful novel set in a seaside town. She never finished it. Now, noted screenwriter Andrew Davies finishes the story and brings it to the television.

Sanditon tells the story of the joyously impulsive, spirited and unconventional Charlotte Heywood and her spiky relationship with the humorous, charming Sidney Parker. When a chance accident transports her from her rural hometown of Willingden to the would-be coastal resort of the eponymous title, it exposes Charlotte to the intrigues and dalliances of a seaside town on the make, and the characters whose fortunes depend on its commercial success. The twists and turns of the plot, which takes viewers from the West Indies to the rotting alleys of London, exposes the hidden agendas of each character and sees Charlotte discover herself and ultimately find love.



While losing good people is the negative aspect of term limits, the good part of it is that it brings new blood into our organization. This year we have three excellent new people joining our board. Laine Larson of Brainerd, Millie Baird of Cass Lake, and Steve Berry of Bemidji are all new additions for 2020. If you know any of these folks, please thank them for volunteering to serve on our board. A special part of our annual meeting every year is when we get to honor an extraordinary volunteer with an award called the John Yourd Pillar Award. John Yourd was one of the founders of Lakeland PBS and worked tirelessly for over ten years to bring public television to Northern Minnesota throughout the 70s. His dream was realized when KAWB channel 9 went on the air in June of 1980 serving northern Minnesota. John was also instrumental in helping bring KAWB channel 22 to the Brainerd lakes area in 1988. John was not only generous with his time, but also with his treasure. John and his wife Dana donated their lake home to Lakeland PBS shortly before John passed away in 1999. John had terminal cancer at the time and John and Dana set up a charitable gift annuity so that Dana would be taken care of with a fixed quarterly payment for life from the proceeds of the funds they donated. John and Dana’s past contribution to Lakeland PBS is still helping Lakeland PBS to this day through our endowment fund. This year, Mike Smith was honored as our 2019 John Yourd Pillar Award recipient. ### Chet Atkins: Certified Guitar Player

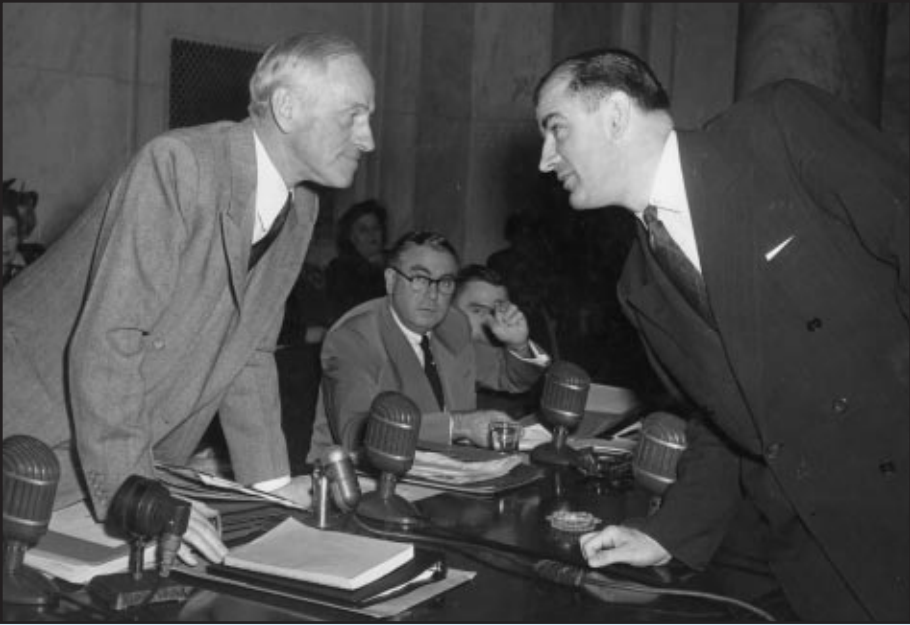

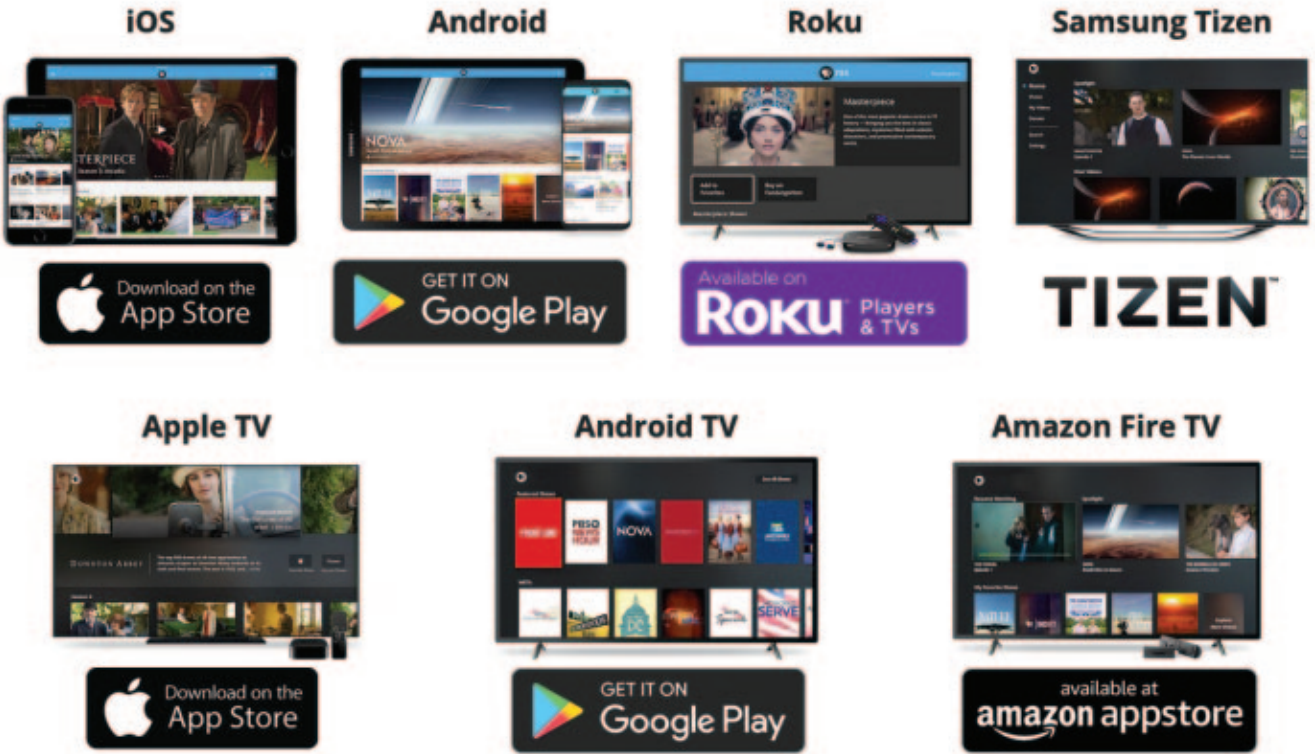
